Health and Safety Procedures

 - Please fill up from the front and sit only where you see a service book. **Please take the pew sheet but NOT the service booklet when you leave.** No hymn books will be used.
 - Leave from the back rows first.
- Please avoid chatting on entering and leaving church, but go straight to your seat.
- Children will need to remain seated with family groups, so please bring appropriate distractions as necessary. Sidespeople will be available to help, should you require them.
- **Please place your offering in the box, at the rear of church, either before or after the service.**

Important notice about the end of restrictions.

On July 19th, Covid restrictions will officially and legally end. However, it is the decision of the clergy and PCCs of this Benefice that, for the moment, we will continue to maintain safety protocols.

As those who are called to love one another, we have a responsibility to put the needs of others ahead of our own needs. Amongst our congregation, we number some vulnerable people and some who are anxious about the ending of restrictions. All have the right to attend worship and none should be prevented from doing so because they don't feel safe. For this reason we would like to encourage you to continue to wear your mask and exercise social distancing for worship, if not for your own protection then out of concern for inclusivity and the welfare of your sisters and brothers in Christ. Thank you for your gracious understanding.
